**INGESTION: COUGHING, DIZZINESS**

Medical Conditions Generally Aggravated by Exposure  
**SKIN: MAY AGGRAVATE AN EXISTING DERMATITIS**

Emergency and First Aid Procedures  
**EYES: FLUSH WITH PLENTY OF WATER AT LEAST 15 MINUTES, USE A BORATE SOLUTION TO NEUTRALIZE.**

**SEE PHYSICIAN. SKIN: WASH WITH PLENTY OF WATER AND SOAP. INGESTION: DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.**

Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled  
**DIKE AND CONTAIN. ABSORB SPILLAGE WITH AN ABSORBENT MATERIAL (SAND, EARTH ABSORBENT PILLOWS)**

**AVOID RUNOFF TO DRAINS; CLEAN AREA AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.**

Waste Disposal Method  
**DISPOSE ACCORDING FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL REGULATIONS.**
